Our Aim:

In a safe, loving, and calm environment that builds confidence and self-reliance in children from 45 days (about 1 and a half months) to 5 years of age through educational activities that instill in them Danem's love of learning.

Terms and Conditions

1. Working hours:

- Monday through Thursday, from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- The school day is from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

2. Ages Allowed:

We accept children from 5 days up to 5 years old.

3. Confirmation of seat reservation:

- The child's seat in the nursery must be confirmed if all required documents and registration fees have been received, and the administration may
- Accept or reject according to the available places.

4. Settling into the new environment:

- We want to get the child settled in the nursery as quickly and painlessly as possible.
- Some children need their mothers to sit with them for a while until they regain their confidence to be able to say goodbye to their mothers without shedding tears
- Some children are ready to join us right away.
- We always strive to gain your trust and cooperate with each other in a simple and easy way.

5. Arrival and departure from the nursery:

- ❖ When children arrive at the nursery in the morning, they are welcomed, and their names are recorded in the attendance book.
- ❖ At dismissal, the child will leave with the responsible person whose name we have in our records, and we will not hand over the child to any
- to anyone you tell us about unless recommended by you, and the child will not leave with a sibling unless the sibling is over the age of 18.

6. Nursery Closure Policy:

- In conjunction with the nursery's policy to assist working mothers, we will only close if the Department of Education and Knowledge or the UAE government
- tells us that we must close.

- ❖ If we must close the nursery due to natural disasters or force majeure circumstances beyond our control, such as power outages, etc.
- We are obliged to provide an alternative place to receive the children.

7. Electronics and Toys/Jewelry... In the Nursery:

- Please do not use a cell phone in the nursery as it may confuse everyone. It is possible to simply make calls outside.
- ❖ The nursery policy only allows photos to be taken with the nursery camera, and you will have access to your child's photos throughout the year
- through our website and your accounts, which we will provide to you privately. Photos will be uploaded weekly by our staff.
- ❖ We do not use computers or tablets in the nursery because we believe that electronics are not appropriate in the nursery.
- ❖ The nursery, therefore, will take the child's devices if they are provided from home and return them to them when they return home.

8. Diapers:

- For children who wear diapers, please send enough for the duration of your child's time in the nursery. We promise to monitor your children and their need for frequent diaper changes.
- For mothers who want to teach their children to use the bathroom, please let us know so that we can discuss how to arrange the task together successfully.

9. To follow up:

- ❖ If you have any complaints or queries, please contact the management directly and they will investigate and resolve your issue immediately.
- ❖ If the administrative staff is unable to resolve your issue, the matter will be brought to the nursery principal to investigate the matter and resolve it in the best way.

10. Celebrations:

Al Baloot Al Sagheer Nursery is keen to celebrate all Islamic religious festivals and occasions only and to instill the foundations and religious values healthy.

Celebrating National Occasions:

11. External situations:

- Please be aware that children are more mobile when they come and go from the nursery, and one of them may be behind your car
- at any moment. Therefore, we ask everyone to drive cautiously and reduce your speed when approaching the nursery and parking lots.
- ❖ Do not leave your car's engine running with a child inside.
- We do not take any responsibility for cars parked at the nursery.

12. Dealing with behavioral issues:

❖ As we are a Montessori preschool, we are committed to guiding children to self-control. Children will not be treated in a rude manner or in a harsh or sharp tone. Our Islamic and Montessori education system stipulates respect for all Big, small, animals and humans. Therefore, there will be no rude treatment of children and the staff will not be tolerated for such an act which may lead to dismissal and legal action against him/her.

13. Uniforms:

- ❖ The Nursery provides simple, comfortable and inexpensive uniforms to suit the children when they join the nursery.
- Children are required to wear house slippers or house socks in the nursery.

14. Lockers:
